

Alessandro Nasi

Alessandro Nasi was born in Turin (Italy) in 1974; he grew up in New York and then returned to Italy where he obtained a degree in Economics at the University of Turin.

He started his career as a financial analyst in several banks, gaining experience at Europlus Asset Management - a division of Unicredito in Dublin - Pricewaterhouse Coopers in Turin, Merrill Lynch and JP Morgan in New York. He then joined JP Morgan Partners in New York as an Associate in their Private Equity Division.

In 2005 he joined Fiat Group as a Corporate and Business Development manager, heading the APAC division. In this role, he was involved in supporting the activities of the Fiat Group sectors in developing their businesses in Asia Pacific. In 2007 he was appointed Vice President of Business Development and a member of the Steering Committee of Fiat Powertrain Technologies, the Engine and Powertrain division of Fiat Group.

At the beginning of 2008 he took on a new responsibility at CNH, the Fiat Group company which manufactures agricultural machinery and construction equipment, of which he was Senior Vice President of Business Development until September 2013. From October 2009 to January 2011 he was also Senior Vice President for Network Development. From January 2011 to January 2019 Mr. Nasi held the position of Secretary of the Industrial Executive Council of Fiat Industrial, continuing in the role of Executive Coordinator to the successor Group Executive Council of CNH Industrial. From September 2013 until January 2019 he was President Specialty Vehicles of CNH Industrial.

From April 2019 he is member of the Board of CNH Industrial.

He is a Director of Giovanni Agnelli B.V. and the Vice Chairman of the board of EXOR N.V.
